### COPYRIGHT CONTROVERSIES

German libraries are protesting against parts of the proposed EU copyright reform. The German Library Association [issued a statement](#) (link in German) saying that while a modernized copyright remains a common goal, some aspects of the current proposal would disregard "library values". The targets of most criticism are article 11 and 13 that could lead to a form of link tax and to necessary implementations of upload filters.

Following the cancellation of the agreement with Elsevier, Norway is confronted with a bunch of new questions. Like what were the true reasons the deal wasn't renewed? How will Norwegian institutions and libraries cope with a future without the largest publisher of academic literature?
